Role purpose

You will be responsible for advancing our technology and security strategy and leading the Technology Team. Through your expert coaching and change management skills, you'll develop a high performing team and an environment of continuous improvement. You will be a key member of the Finance and Resources directorate leadership team, helping to shape and deliver a first-class service to all colleagues across the Fund and ensuring our specialist technology support is aligned with our strategic direction. The Technology Team consists of specialist IT functions that this role is accountable for Systems & Governance, IT Support & Operations, IT Security, Business Engagement, Contract & Financial Management. In addition, you will have oversight of our Facilities function ensuring Government directives and property strategy standards are followed.

You will be responsible for the implementation of appropriate standards, tools and applications to improve organisation performance, aligned to a range of complex technical requirements and best practice frameworks.

In an increasingly hostile operating environment, you will lead on and be accountable for the design of the Fund's cyber security services and providing assurance to the Fund that technical security controls are appropriate, are regularly and rigorously tested, comply with regulatory frameworks, and embed best practice (e.g. Cyber Essentials Plus and GovAssure etc). You will provide assurance on service delivery, service development and cyber security to our Senior Management Team and Audit & Risk Committee.

You will be responsible/accountable for:

- The design and continuous improvement of all technology infrastructure services.
- Understand the Fund's strategy, goals, culture to deliver relevant solutions with a focus on supporting our digital ambitions in collaboration with the Deputy Director Digital.
- Implement modern and sector leading security measures to ensure the Fund's technology and digital assets remain secure.
- Ensure disaster recover and business continuity protocols are in place, tested and optimised for rapid system restoration.
- Support in the provision of relevant data management platforms to enable the Fund to achieve its impact and data ambitions
- Deliver modern, reliable and accessible technology solutions
- Provide business engagement, consultancy, and analysis services to the Fund
- Implement and maintain business systems for contract, financial and GDPR compliance.
- Manage relationships with external suppliers for procurement of technology services and goods.
- Manage a budget of £10m and lead of circa 50 people who are dispersed across different locations
- Have strategic oversight of the Facilities Team in managing the Fund's property and estate workplace facilities ensuring compliance with the Government Property Agency standards and National Property Controls



Key responsibilities

- Advance our technology and security strategies and lead the Technology Team to provide technology solutions and support services that are aligned with the Fund's strategic direction.
- Design and continuous improvement of technology infrastructure and services, whilst ensuring value for money.
- Deliver a solutions-orientated Customer-First mindset, notably focussing on how Technology and Digital services work seamlessly to deliver strategic solutions by delivering high quality business engagement, consultancy and analysis services which add strategic added value to customer teams across the Fund.
- Implement standards, tools and applications to improve organisation performance and protect the Fund's data, information and assets from external threat.
- Ensure security services and technical security controls are fit for purpose, and that sector leading best practice is used as a benchmark.
- Implement and maintain robust business systems around contract, financial and GDPR compliance.
- Advance the property and estates strategy and lead the Facilities Team to maintain collaborative and social spaces that meet relevant regulations and standards.

- Significant experience at a senior level in IT, and a practiced understanding of the "enabling partner" role IT can play within an organisation.
